## What is the Turkey River Classic?

## What is Valley Mentoring?

Valley Mentoring is a certified Mentoring Program through the Iowa Mentoring Partnership. Valley Mentoring is an initiative of the Valley Community Coalition (VCC), a grassroots coalition whose mission is to reduce illegal substance abuse among youth in the Valley community. Valley Mentoring benefits youth and families in the Valley community!

### Here's how it works:

- ANY Valley Youth in grades K-12 can sign up for the program, pending parental approval
- ANY adult in the community 18 and over can apply to be a Mentor
- Mentors and Mentees are then matched based on interests, hobbies, and personality
- Mentors spend 4-6 hours per month engaging in positive activities with their mentees, such as planting trees, bowling, going to movies, playing games, golfing, and lots more!
- Valley Mentoring benefits everyone by creating positive connections between youth and adults!

The Valley Mentoring Program relies entirely on fund-raising efforts and local donations to sustain a part-time Mentoring Coordinator and program needs. The Turkey River Classic is the primary funding source to keep the program running!

The TRC III raised nearly \$18,000 toward sustaining Valley Mentoring. The goal of the Turkey River Classic IV is to increase that amount to \$20,000.00!
